

Whistle Blowing



(Expressing concern about a member of staff)

- Do you feel uncomfortable about how a staff member acts or speaks with the children?
- Are you concerned about the safety of the children at your setting?
- Then you must follow the procedures your setting has in place and tell the Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL)
- If you unable to speak to the DSL, then speak to another senior member of staff (for example: Deputy DSL, Room Leader, Director).

ARE YOU NOT SATISFIED WITH HOW YOUR CONCERN HAS BEEN HANDLED BY THE SENIOR MEMBER OF STAFF IN YOUR SETTING

- You <u>must</u> contact both **Medway Council** and then **Ofsted**
- You should contact Medway Council First Response service first
 (If Medway council First response are not available you must inform Ofsted of this)
